



## CALL FOR PAPERS

### Thematic Section: Teaching Geography

The editorial committee of *Tlalli. Revista de Investigación en Geografía* is pleased to announce the opening of its call for submissions of academic works (articles, reviews, or reflective essays) under the theme “Teaching Geography.” This call for papers aims to gather original research and innovative reflections addressing the teaching of geography in various educational contexts, from teaching geography at different levels of primary, secondary, and high school education to training geographers at higher education and postgraduate levels.

Given the recent emergence of new educational offerings related to geography, this call seeks to encourage reflection on what is taught about the discipline and how. We are interested in exploring pedagogical and epistemological approaches (e.g., Pastrán, Montilla, and Castillo, 2017; Rojas, 2005); teaching methodologies (e.g., Bozzano et al., 2016; Buitrago, 2005); participatory mapping and the use of technologies (e.g., Álvarez, McCall, and León, 2022); practical experiences (e.g., Fernández and Gurevich, 2007); interdisciplinary work (e.g., Ribera, 2005); dissemination and outreach (e.g., Espinoza, 2019); and current challenges in geographic education (e.g., SEP, 2022).

We invite researchers, educators, and professionals in the fields of geography and education to submit their works on innovative methodologies in the teaching of geography; integration of digital technologies in geographic education; case studies on successful practices in geography classrooms; challenges and solutions in the training of geography teachers; development of geographic competencies in students at various educational levels; critical perspectives on geography curricula; geography and environmental and civic education; assessment and measurement of geographic learning; among other topics.

In addition to works under the indicated theme, we will also accept articles for the general section of the issue, which may address any geographical approach or focus on topics directly related to geography, provided they adhere to *Tlalli's* **editorial guidelines** and **journal regulations**.

The deadline for manuscript submissions for this issue is **December 1, 2024**. These must be submitted through the journal's editorial manager (OJS) (<https://revistas.filos.unam.mx/index.php/tlalli/index>).
